



## **QUALIFIED PRIMARY SCHOOL TEACHER WITH AUSLAN QUALIFICATIONS OR SKILLS / KNOWLEDGE 2018 (0.6FTE)**

Our Lady of Mercy is seeking a qualified Primary Teacher to teach AUSLAN to students across Pre-Primary through to Year 6. This is a double-stream Catholic Primary school located in Girrawheen. AUSLAN will be taught as the school's second language. The Teacher will work from the Australian Curriculum as SCSA has not yet developed a Western Australian AUSLAN Curriculum. The Teacher will be given support to plan a whole school scope and sequence for this Learning Area. The Teacher will be given additional training where requested or required. Formal AUSLAN qualifications are highly desirable, however a proven ability to use AUSLAN proficiently will suffice. The school will provide a small amount of funds for AUSLAN specific resources and materials at the request of the teacher. The teacher will be responsible for:

- Teach, plan and assess students' AUSLAN knowledge and understanding from Pre-Primary through to Year 6
- Completing reports for all students from Year 1 through to Year 6 in Term 2 and Term 4
- Become an active member of the OLOM professional learning community by attending all relevant staff meetings, cluster meetings and staff committee meetings
- Maintain instructional materials and electronic files/records (e.g. lesson plans, Daily Work Pads, Forward Planning Documents, Scope and Sequence documents, attendance, pencils, paper, teaching supplies, etc.)
- Communicate with supervising instructional staff and professional support personnel for the purpose of assisting in evaluating progress and/or implementing student specific learning objectives.
- Develop teaching and learning programs which are in line with the school's philosophy on education
- Work collaboratively with their co-teacher and all staff, both teaching and non-teaching
- Have an 'open door' policy
- Encourage parent participation and develop strong home-school links
- Abide by the Catholic Ethos
- Abide by contractual duty of care times, (be punctual)
- Model the school's vision and core values by integrating this across all facets of school life
- Abide by all school policies and practices
